








Side effect of drugs

Hair loss concurrent with taking one of the drugs listed in the accompanying table does not indicate that the drug is the sole cause of hair loss. 
Hair Loss and Alopecias

Hair loss distresses most patients, independently from its severity and pattern. In some cases, the decrement in quality of life attributable to hair loss is comparable with that caused by major chronic diseases.

I-P studies have mainly applied different mainstream theories such as finance theory of portfolio diversification, the resource-based view transaction cost economies, and organizational learning theory to understand how internationalization affects company performance (Hennart, 2007; Tsao and Chen, 2010).
